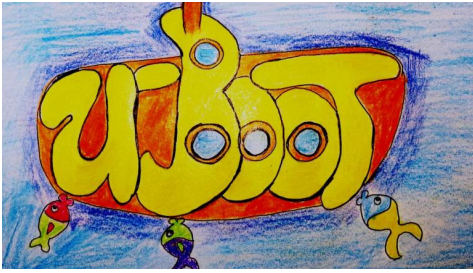


## The submarine



As they search for the rescue submarine, everyone is in the dark. Yet it's in the middle of the ocean, acting all calm while everyone else searches excitedly.

A fun icebreaker where there is no loser.

## General framework

- **Group size:** from 8 people
- **Location:** preferably in one room - watch out for tripping hazards!
- **Duration:** 5-10 minutes

## Material

- Something to blindfold the eyes.

## Implementation

1. All players are blindfolded. (If necessary, it is also sufficient to close your eyes).
2. The game master secretly appoints a player as a deputy. (He can take the blindfold off again).
3. The game begins:
  1. The game begins and everyone sets off in search of the rescue submarine. They ask everyone they meet: 'Submarine?' If the other player answers with the same question, it is clear that it is not the submarine.
  2. The selected player, who is the submarine, behaves very quietly. When he is found, he gives no answer. The fish stays with him and together they now form a larger submarine - the blindfolds are removed.

The game is over when everyone has found the submarine.
