In 8 afternoons learn about biblical cities/sites

Sodom and Gomorrah, Genesis 19

The cities were destroyed because they did not listen to God.

Egypt, Genesis 1

The Israelites live in Egypt among themselves in small huts. They are kept as slaves by Pharaoh.

Jerusalem

Discussion of the city of Jerusalem e.g. how David took it or the entry of Jesus, young Jesus' visit to the temple....

Babylon, 2 Kings 24

The people of Israel are carried off to Babylon.

Susa - Esther, Esther 1 (ff.)

Susa is the city where Esther lived and ministered.

Nineveh / Tarsis, Jonah

Jonah is told by God to go to Nineveh, but instead he goes to Tarsis - why does he want to go to one city rather than the other?

Rome, Acts 28:11 ff.

Stand by faith and proclaim it, no matter what situation you are in.

Heavenly Jerusalem, Revelation 21

What must I do to enter the kingdom of heaven? What happens in the "new Jerusalem"?
