

1. Features

2. Groups and staff structure

The classic YS age is 9-13 years, give or take 1-2 years. We strive to have children's, teen, and youth work build on each other and make the transition. Through the Risingstars concept, teens already have the opportunity to actively participate and grow in responsibility. Maturity and responsibility cannot necessarily be linked to age, so age definitions are only a guide.

- rising star: teen helper, little leader
- helper: e.g. in photography, kitchen, etc.
- leader
- small group leader
- main person in charge, team leader
- instructor, training assistant
- coach

The training system is adapted to the development of the staff and offers valuable training for all levels - according to responsibilities and tasks.
