### Jungschar in public

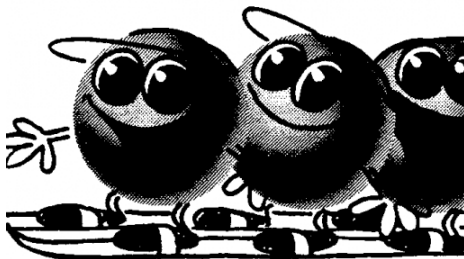

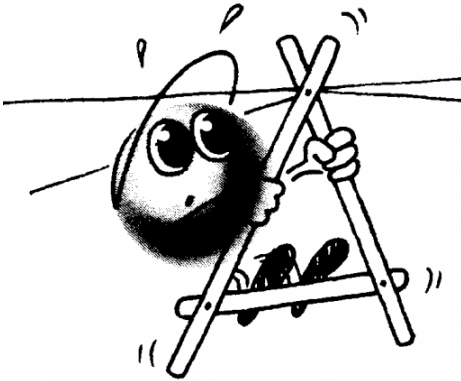
