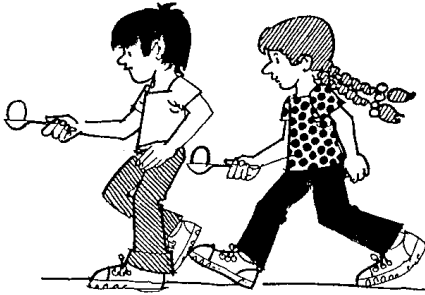


Game pedagogy

What do games trigger and what do we, as staff, aim to do with them?

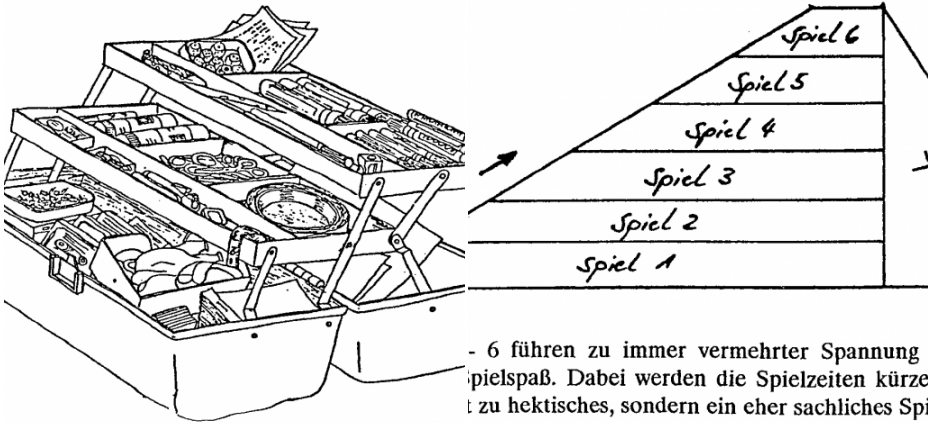
