

T-shirts dye



Cool custom t-shirt dyeing with the youngsters!

Procedure

- 12:30 - Leader meeting and prepare
- 13:00 - Leader meeting
- 14:00 - Welcome
- 14:10 - Instruction billets
- 14:15 - Billets, parallel provide hot water with paint
- 14:45 - Off to the Kettle
- 15:00 - Devotion
- 15:20 - Singing
- 15:35 - Z'Vieri
- 16:00 - Pantsack Games
- 17:00 - End+ T-shirt Return

Information

This program can be done with children and teens of any age. Younger children may need some help, but will be just as excited about the results as the older ones.

Divide into sensible groups for clubbing; ~5 cauldrons for for dyeing

The children tie the strings around the t-shirts. **Important: the strings must be full!**

Lift up a piece of fabric & tie off with string at the bottom. The more fabric, the bigger the circle at the end. If you want you can also wrap your t-shirt wildly with a little string at the end. This creates thin stripes.

The longer the T-shirts are in the color, the more intense the color is at the end.

- Sanibox
- Plastic bags
- Dyeing supplies (paint, table salt)
- Camera
- Snack
- Gummeli (wide)
- Guitar
- T-shirts
- Kettle
- Sturdy string
- Stencil ("Jungschi(Anker)")
- T-shirt spray can black (1 can = approx. 10 t-shirts)
- Scissors
- Stick
