Children also have basic emotional needs

Basic needs

that must primarily be satisfied by the family:

- The need to be loved, accepted and wanted
- to be noticed and affirmed
- ... after expansion of the living space (expansion)
- ... after identification with values, attitudes, and behavioral norms
- ... after being included in a family community

Basic needs that must primarily find their satisfaction outside the family:

- ... after adapted teaching
- ... Being accepted by the group
- ... Inclusion in the adult world
