We continue with praise and sharing. The sharing has a key message " As the sheep listen to the voice of their shepherd, I listen to the voice of God" with a selected passage John 10:4-5, verse 16 and 27-29

### Verse to learn

The verse to learn is John 10:27. It can be done in some creative way. For example, the words of the verse could be written on paper cut-out sheep. The children will each have a sheep, but one of the children will take on the role of "shepherd" who will need to help the "sheep" line up correctly to line up the verse.

### Homework

Homework for next time is for the children to bring in 5 different types of tree leaves and of course know what kind of trees they are from.
