We put a rope ladder on top of a barn and put a basket of bird stickers on top of the rope step. The aim is for the children to climb up and get a sticker. The children can go through a few times if they wish.

Praise and sharing

We continue with praise and sharing. Sharing has a key message "Let us be willing to help and make friends without prejudice" using the passage Luke 10:25-27.

Verse to learn

The verse to learn was Matthew 7:12. You can make it creative and accessible for children so they can easily understand and learn it.

Homework

The homework we set them for next time is to bring in empty eggshells because we will use them during the next EPA afternoon and do something with them.
