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Game with posts



- Number of players- 30
- Leaders 8+1 to lead the game
- Age group- 9-12
- Terrain- field
- 1. Sheets are placed on the ground and either a foot or a hand is depicted on them. Each child has to be able to put their hand and foot on the corresponding sheet.
- 2. Different sized buckets are placed on the field for the children to put a table tennis ball into and they have to make a certain number of points (for example 400). Each bucket carries a different number of points.
- 3. The field is prepared as for a board game. The children have to go through all the squares and each square may have a challenge or a question. There may also simply be bonus points that are added to the team's final score.
- 4. The team is divided into 2 groups. One group gets a pair of ouzie stoppers for each, and the other group gets a slip of paper with a word on it for each as well. The goal is to have the kids who have the word explain with just gestures without talking to the kids who have earplugs.
- 5. The last post is a game of sea chess with people.

The winner is the team that gets the most points from all the posts.
