A verse to remember

The verse to memorize is Matthew 10:32. The verse was printed on A4 sheets so that each child had a copy. On the sheet are highlighted letters of different colours to form words for the children to find. The words are 'Jesus' and 'reward', but the children are given another task which is to make a word related to the topic from the letters that are in the text.

Small groups

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We divide the children into two groups up to and including age 10 in one group and age 11 and up in the other group. The small groups discuss what is being said during the sharing. In the first group up to 10 years it should be more active like games or manual work. The group from 11 years upwards have a discussion on the topic.
