Events

- Servius Sulpicius Galba became Roman consul
- Emperor Tiberius establishes a credit bank in Rome
- Rome is hit by a financial crisis
- Drusus Caesar, son of Germanicus and Agrippina the elder, and adopted son of Tiberius dies. He is the brother of Emperor Caligula
- Agrippina the elder dies (starvation death, possibly from hunger strike)
- Gaius Rubellius Plautus, son of Gaius Rubellius Blandus and Julia, is born. He would become known as a political rival of Emperor Nero
- Jesus Christ dies by crucifixion, but rises from the dead after 3 days
- The Holy Spirit is poured out

Why is this year important?
