

Tangerine peel figures



How to create figures from cassava shells.

Material

- Manderines (or fresh peel)
- small guazle molds (baking tins)
- two sheets of white paper
- Newspaper
- Books

Procedure

- Choose the manderines so that the areas are as large as possible.
- Cut figures out of the shells using the cutting molds.
- Press the figures by placing them between two sides of white paper, which in turn is placed between newspapers. Books are stacked on top.
- The whole stack is left to stand for 4-5 days.
- To allow the shells to dry better, change the paper and newspaper on the first and second day.
- Done!
