

## Piip game



A short, reassuring game.

### Game data

- **Age:** from 7 years
- **Number:** 6 +
- **Terrain:** outdoors (meadow/field) or indoors
- **Leader:** 1
- **Duration:** 5 min +

### Material

If possible, something to cover the children's eyes (cloth, scarf, ...) so that they can't see anything! Even if it is possible to play outside, a clear boundary of the playing field is necessary (e.g. barrier tape).

### Preparation

No preparation is necessary for this game.

### Game procedure

- \* Everyone is blindfolded.
- \* The game leader pats someone on the back. This person is -Piip- during the game.
- \* Now everyone walks around. No talking is allowed and it should be very quiet. When two people touch each other, they say "piip". Only -Piip- remains silent. So if -Piip- comes across someone, says "piip" and receives no response, he shakes hands with -Piip- and from then on also remains silent.

## **End of the game**

The game ends as soon as everyone shakes hands. If the players have not listened carefully, there may be several "human chains".
